Ballots Mailed

Vote in APWU Election of National Union Officers

09/23/2016 - Ballots for the American Postal Workers Union's 2016 election of national officers were mailed to all eligible APWU members Sept. 10-15.

To be counted, the ballots must be returned to and received in the designated post office box by 2 p.m. (EDT) on Wednesday, Oct. 5. To be eligible to vote, a member must have been in "good standing" according to the official records of the national union on June 24.
